

Good news ! The ESS Les Paccots is ready to welcome snowsports enthusiasts !

In order to ensure that everything goes as smoothly as possible and that we can guarantee the best sports experience for everyone please read and respect the health measures we are putting in place.

Before the class

- Book in advance (online www.esslepaccots.ch, or by phone 021 948 78 86
- Lessons must be paid in full before the start of the first class
- Please download the **SwissCovid application**
- If you have any symptoms, stay home

Upon arrival

- Follow the signs and instructions given in the station
- Present your proof of purchase to gain access to the Verollys / Borbuintze parking
- 1 adult – 1 child
- Mandatory mask from 12 years old on the parking area and in the Paccots resort
- Put your little one down and make way for the following parents, the ESS supervisor will be there to guide him
- Only those who do not have the following contraindications can participate in the class _
 - are not infected with the coronavirus
 - do not show a body [temperature higher than 38 degrees](#)
 - are not under medical evaluation for coronavirus infection
 - do not have symptoms of Covid-19 that have not been tested for linkage to this disease
 - do not have acute coronavirus infection in their immediate environment (parents, roommates, co-workers, etc,...) are allowed to participate in the class

On the slopes and outdoors in all public places (parking, squares, streets)

- Nasal-mouth mask **mandatory on all ski lifts, in the queues (cash desks, lifts)**, in the parking areas and in Les Paccots resort
- Respect distance of 1.5m (or an adult ski) between each person in the queues and during the group stops
- During breaks, snacks, toilet, etc, wash and disinfect your hands
- **The ESS Les Paccots reserves the right to exclude any person who does not comply with the measures taken with immediate effect and without cashback**
- If you feel bad during the class, immediately notify the instructor.
